Personal Hygiene

1. Towels - not white, hotels usually use that color and you don't want to mix them up
2. Toothpaste, Toothbrush, floss Soap/ Body wash
3. Shampoo and Conditioner Q-tips
4. Hair brush, product, pins/ties/scrunchi/etc
5. Deodorant
6. Air Freshener (good against bathroom smells)
7. Toilet Paper - mostly if you are going to have a lot of people in your room. I've known people who were in rooms that ran out
8. Contacts with case and solution (extra contacts)
9. Glasses
10. Mouthwash Razor and Shaving Cream
11. Feminine Hygiene

Sleeping Comfort

1. Pillows – no white pillow cases Blankets and/or sleeping bags
2. Something to sleep in Sinus meds (see medical needs)

Medical Needs

1. Prescription medications Pain killers
2. Sinus Meds: new place means new allergens. Plus, helps prevent snoring.
3. Eyeglass Repair Kit Ear Plugs

Food and Snacks

1. Granola/ Protein/ Cereal Bars Cup-a-noodle
2. Easy Mac or Easy Hamburger Helper Fruit
3. Chips Canned Food
4. Bread Peanut Butter and Jelly
5. Crackers Cheese
6. Lunch meat Rice
7. Fondue needs Poptarts
8. Hot Pockets
9. Drinks

To Fix your food/ drinks

1. Hot water and/ or coffee pot (I take an electric tea pot and H2O pot)
2. Mini-microwave Mini/ Travel Fridge
3. Plates Cups
4. Bowles Silverware
5. Paper towels Fondue Pot
6. Cooler/ ice chest – may need more than one.
7. Get Ice BEFORE you get to the hotel
8. Rice Cooker Hot plate/ electric skillet
9. Sealable containers – so food doesn't get soaked in your ice chest

Personal Gadgets

1. Cell Phone / PDA Charger
2. DS, PSP, etc? Charger
3. Two-way radios Charger
4. Computer (you guessed it) Charger
5. Camera/ Camcorder EXTRA Memory/Film/Download cable
6. Charger or batteries
7. Media Player (Ipod, etc) Charger
8. Power strip – you are bringing a lot of chargers, and not a lot of plugs What to wear

Clothing and Misc

1. Clothing + 2days Something to put dirty clothes in
 2. Comfortable shoes – new ones can give you blisters
 3. Buying Items
 4. Bring Cash – ATMs onsite usually run out (I try to take \$200 in \$1 bills)
 5. Cash Box (if room doesn't have a safe – call hotel to find out before you arrive)
- *Lock Money you aren't going to spend in your room.
6. Cardboard Tube – for posters, so they don't get damaged
 7. A bag to pack them in – for when you leave.

Autographs

1. Items to be autographed
2. Sharpie/ autograph markers – this way, you can choose your color
3. Nice to have items
4. Post-it notes and a pen – leave a message for your roomies

1. Costume and Accessories
